Responding to your letter of February 23, 2006, in particular your revelation that certain evidence has been either lost or destroyed, we need a little more information. Your letter states that "most of the physical evidence in this case has either been lost or destroyed". You then state that the evidence from the Porsche, the handgun, the shell casing and the projectile are gone. You state that "the evidence that is remaining was seized from your client..." Is there any other physical evidence? What about the latent fingerprint cards analyzed back in 1996 and 1997 by the crime lab? It would be very helpful if the State could provide a list containing each and every piece of physical evidence still in existence, where it is and its custodian.

Whatever physical evidence still exists I would like to examine. Would you have Investigator Harvey or Ms. Baker contact me to arrange this opportunity?
